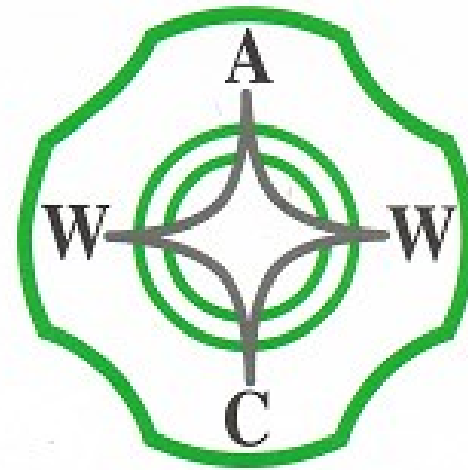

ACWW's project fund for rural women committed to the SDGs (the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals)

The Women Empowered Fund was launched in 2018 as ACWW's new funding initiative for projects. By supporting one of the six Focus

Area pots below, you'll see how you are making a difference to communities around the world.

ACWW projects allow you to support real-life changes for women in rural communities around the world. They are women-led, designed by women in their own communities who know best what they need, and they are funded through local women's organizations to ensure maximum impact.

When you donate to one of the following Priority Focus Areas, you support projects which promote:

1. Education and capacity building

- *Literacy for adults and children*
- *Skill training*
- *Adult education*
- *Primary education for all children*
- *Leadership development*
- *Community development and training in organization and leadership in the field of social welfare*

2. Nutrition good health and well being

- *Family welfare, primary health and first-aid training*
- *Health education and awareness of widespread communicable and no communicable diseases*
- *Education in nutrition*
- *Food safety awareness*

3. Sustainable Agriculture Training and Development

- *Small items of equipment*
- *Organic and sustainable agricultural techniques*
- *Establishment of seed banks and support groups for small scale farmers*

4. Income generation and livelihood

- *Small business initiatives*
- *Revolving loan schemes*
- *Business skills development*

5. Sustainable water sanitation and energy

- *Access to water*
- *Water conservation and security*
- *Improvement and access to sanitation facilities*

6. Maternal and reproductive health

- *Promotion of breast feeding*
- *Practices to reduce maternal mortality*
- *Prevention of female genital mutilation*
- *Education and access to sexual and reproductive health and rights*
